- **March Madness and Music** on Sunday, March 1, will be another Men's Club breakfast that will feature, as always, scrumptious food and some music as well!

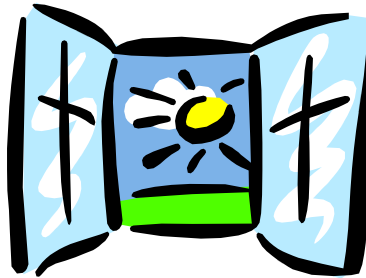
