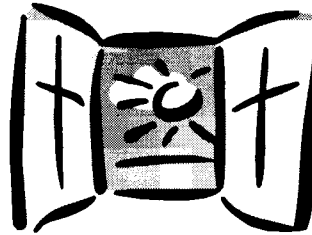

Announcing: The St. Mary School Latchkey and Pre-School Day Care Program:

Great news that will make the lives of parents easier!

Beginning next school year St. Mary School will offer a Pre-School Day Care and School Age Latchkey Program.

Many parents have expressed interest in having these options in our school to help meet the

demands of their busy schedule and to provide a faith-based care program for their children. Each of these programs will be taught by current St. Mary teaching staff.

The K-8 Latchkey program will be available before and after school for up to 18 students. (Session I from 6:30am - 8:10am Session II from 3:30pm - 6:00pm) Parents can bring their children in early before school and pick them up later after school in a supervised setting. Price is determined by the session for each child.

The Pre-School Day Care Program will provide pre-school parents several care options for their child. Morning pre-schoolers will be able to stay into the afternoon in a different Day Care classroom supervised by a qualified staff member. Afternoon pre-school children can attend the morning Day Care session and transfer to the pre-school classroom at the appropriate time.

The Day Care program will focus on exploring children's interests and developing empathy for others. Fees will be assessed by the day or session to give parents the flexibility to fit their busy schedule.

Once the form and essays are ready, turn them in to the school office. Address the envelope to the attention of the Berger Scholarship Committee, and the process is complete. Nothing could be easier! So please, if you are taking lessons and love music, apply for this scholarship. You never know where your music might take you. (Applications are due to the school office **by Friday, May 15**. If you are a previous award winner there is an extra step for you, so read your application carefully.)
